On or about at least one day after the end of the comment period the Town of Greenwich will authorize the Housing Authority of the Town of Greenwich to submit a request to HUD for the release of funds under Section 18 of the Housing Act of 1937, as amended, to undertake a project known as Quarry Knoll I for the purpose of demolishing 50 physically obsolete units and building approximately 240 new units of affordable elderly and disabled housing located at 50 Quarry Knoll Rd.

The activities proposed comprise a project for which a Finding of No Significant Impact on the environment was made and is published simultaneously with this Notice. An Environmental Assessment (EA) that documents the environmental determinations for this project is on file at the Housing Authority of the Town of Greenwich, 249 Milbank Avenue and may be examined or copied weekdays between 9 A.M and 4 P.M.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the EA to the Town of Greenwich Corporation Counsel's office, All comments must be received by July 6, 2024.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The Town of Greenwich certifies to HUD that Fred Camillo in his capacity as First Selectman of the Town of Greenwich consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the Housing Authority of the Town of Greenwich to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of funds and the Town of Greenwich's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Town of Greenwich; (b) the Town of

Greenwich has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD at 20 Church St. Hartford, CT 06103. Potential objectors should contact the HUD Hartford Field Office to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
